Including strength per element

Keep in mind when conducting DI and DIO minimum one strength per element receives at least one question scores 100%. Doc only audits only need minimum one strength for the overall audit.

Pandemic related hazards

Auditors are required to verify in their justification findings/notes that Pandemic related hazards have been included in Formal Hazard Assessments. If Pandemic related hazards have not been added to formal hazard assessments 100% cannot be achieved for 2.3. Auditors are required to verify in their justification findings/notes that have been included as a potential emergency in the company's ERP. If pandemics have not been included 100% cannot be achieved for 8.1.

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
