SECOR PROCESS TIMELINE



*First QA review times fluctuate based on volume of audit submissions. The timeline represents the maximum length of time to achieve a SECOR. Certificates issued from Partnerships typically take 2-3 weeks to arrive to AMTA.

What is Quality Assurance Review for SECOR?

The Quality Assurance Reviews ensure that the audit reports meet Partnerships Standards for completeness of information, adequate and representative sampling, and correct application of auditor processes.

All health and safety audits completed for certification or maintenance of SECOR must be completed using the same basic auditing principles and standards in order to ensure the integrity of the audit process and the credibility of audit results.

Audit reports must pass the CP's quality assurance review before the reports can be approved and processed.
